ACHIEVEMENTS OF TASHKENT STATE LAW UNIVERSITY

This article highlights the significant achievements of Tashkent State University of Law (TSUL) in 2023-2024. The article provides a detailed account of the university's success in securing international grants, its positions in prestigious rankings such as Times Higher Education, WURI, and RUR, students' accomplishments in international competitions, as well as achievements in academic activities and international cooperation. The conclusion draws insights into the university's development prospects, emphasizing TSUL's strengthening position in the global academic community and its leading role in Uzbekistan's higher education system.

Introduction

Tashkent State University of Law has achieved significant success at the international level in recent years and holds one of the leading positions in the higher education system of Uzbekistan. The achievements of the university's faculty, students, and staff during 2023-2024 have received high praise not only from the academic community but also from reputable international organizations. In this article, the most significant achievements of TSUL are presented in chronological order with specific examples.

Throughout 2024, the faculty and staff of TSUL have successfully participated in several prestigious international grant programs. Within the framework of such programs as "Erasmus+," "DAAD," "MARS: Non-Western Migration Regimes in a Global Perspective," "Caucasus and Central Asia Research on Social Innovation," "Jean Monnet Chair in European Union Law," "Horizon Europe Framework Programme," "Chevening Scholarship," and the well-known American "FEP," grants totaling 100,000 euros were received. These achievements demonstrate the university's activity in international cooperation and its scientific potential. These grants are important not only from a financial perspective but also for strengthening TSUL's integration with the global academic community.

TSUL has been repeatedly recognized by one of the most authoritative ranking organizations in the world - Times Higher Education (THE). In the Young University Rankings 2023,

compiled for universities under 50 years old, TSUL received the status of "Reporter" university. In this ranking, which included 605 universities, 358 institutions were recognized as "Reporters," and TSUL's inclusion in this list opened up prospects for occupying high positions in the main THE rankings in the future. The organization also expressed its readiness to provide direct support to TSUL.

In the THE Impact Rankings 2023, based on the UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), TSUL entered the TOP-1000 for the first time and ranked 800th overall. This represents an improvement of 200 positions compared to the previous year's result. Notably, the university entered the TOP-500 in 4 areas and showed the following results:

- SDG 5 (Gender Equality) 301st place;
- SDG 8 (Decent Work and Economic Growth) 301st place;
- SDG 16 (Peace, Justice and Strong Institutions) 301st place;
- SDG 4 (Quality Education) 401st place.

Additionally, the university ranked 601st in SDG 10 (Reduced Inequalities) and SDG 17 (Partnerships for the Goals). These achievements confirm TSUL's significant contribution on a global scale not only in the field of law but also in socio-economic and educational matters. In the international "World's Universities with Real Impact" (WURI) ranking, TSUL stood out for its innovative approach. According to the 2023 results, the university ranked 51st in the world in terms of student mobility and openness, and 101st in the global overall ranking. The WURI ranking evaluates innovations in 5 main areas - industrial programs, entrepreneurship, ethical values, student activity, and the fourth industrial revolution. TSUL's success in this ranking indicates its successful adaptation to modern educational standards.

TSUL entered the TOP-200 universities in the Round University Ranking (RUR) subject ranking. This achievement confirms the high level of scientific and academic activity of the university in the field of law and other related areas.

Tashkent State University of Law has achieved significant success at the international level in recent years. Achievements in international grants, high results in prestigious rankings, and strong ties with the global academic community prove that TSUL is becoming one of the leading universities not only in Uzbekistan but also worldwide. These achievements lay the foundation for even greater success in the future and strengthen TSUL's position in international education and scientific research. In 2023, TSUL achieved great success in its academic activities:

- 120 students were sent to foreign higher educational institutions as part of academic exchange programs, and 75 professors and teachers for internships and experience exchange;
- 155 professors, teachers, and staff visited foreign partner organizations, and 28 foreign professors taught at TSUL;
- 64 textbooks and more than 170 teaching aids were prepared, more than 10 foreign textbooks were translated into Uzbek, and more than 800 foreign literature items were acquired;
- Memorandums of cooperation were signed with 10 foreign higher educational institutions and 2 organizations. Foreign partners have allocated more than 10 quotas for doctoral studies and more than 100 preferential places for master's studies.

- The team took 1st place in the Central Asian round of the "Philip C. Jessup International Law Moot Court Competition" and ranked among the TOP-48 teams in the international round.
- The team ranked in the TOP-50 at the international "John H. Jackson" competition.
- They actively participated in international competitions such as "International Criminal Court," "Jean-Pictet Competition," and competitions on Eurasian integration law held in Minsk and Moscow.

University staff participated in 321 international scientific and practical conferences, exhibitions, and events. This once again confirmed TSUL's active involvement in the global scientific community.
