Forming the creative approach skills of primary school students. For this reason, the adults in the family and parents should perform the task of guiding students in doing homework. On the contrary, homework of elementary school students stagnates their creativity.

It is important to train the creative skills of elementary school students to correctly create reality and events. For this, it is important to teach elementary school students to distinguish between good and bad, not to be afraid of complex events, and to accept reality correctly. For example, it is important that elementary school students are taught not to be overwhelmed by certain difficulties. Observations show that elementary school students often face difficulties in mastering new subjects. Therefore, teaching them not to be afraid of such complexities is an important factor in accustoming them to accept reality and events correctly.

It is also important to form a creative attitude to everything in teaching elementary school students to a creative approach. In this sense, creative attitude is a set of overcoming complexities, not being afraid of different situations and reacting with the help of thought. content is created during the lessons. For this, it is necessary for the leaders of primary classes to be active. For this reason, it is appropriate to direct the activities of teachers by class leaders in order to create a creative attitude from primary school students.

If we pay attention, in order to develop creative approach skills in elementary school students, it is important to teach them to do their homework independently, to correctly perceive reality and events, and to develop a creative attitude in them. For this, special approaches of primary school teachers and class leaders are needed.

Forming the creative thinking skills of primary school students. In forming the creative skills of primary school students according to the 4K model, it is important to develop creative thinking in them. For this, it is appropriate to pay attention to the following said:

- 1) teaching to think;
- 2) teaching to express one's opinion;
- 3) teaching to research.

One of the important factors in teaching elementary students to think creatively is to teach them to think. For this, students learn to think about each issue, defend their opinion, and ask questions about what they do not know. learning is important. For example, it is important for primary school students to get used to learning by asking what they don't know. It is known that the desire to know is the basis of thinking. it will be possible to learn not to be and to think by listening to it.

It is also important to teach primary school students to express their thoughts in order to develop their creative thinking skills. For this reason, primary school students should not be shy, shy or wrong when expressing their opinion. should be taught not to be afraid of saying the wrong thing. For example, elementary school students are often afraid of saying the wrong thing



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because they have the idea that they will say the wrong thing. Therefore, according to our approach, if a primary school student is able to speak, he is thinking. This is precisely why it is possible to teach primary school students to express their thoughts.

One of the important foundations of developing creative thinking skills in elementary school students is to teach them to creative research. For this, primary school students are taught to research according to their interest, ability, and mobility. By means of an assignment they can be directed to search. For example, by giving a task of drawing a picture in the subject of fine arts, they can be directed to creative search. Therefore, creative research is an important basis for forming creative thinking in elementary school students.
