Strengthening international cooperation in the field of education serves to strengthen Uzbekistan's position in the global arena. Training programs are being implemented in collaboration with leading universities in the USA, Europe, and Asia.

Youth technoparks and modern laboratories are being established, stimulating students' interest in scientific activities. Special grant programs in the field of IT and technology were introduced in 2023.
