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of Al-Farabi and Beruni, who also believes that the influence of heredity, environment and education is the same environment for child education. He notes that all good and bad behavior is formed as a result of conditions, education, environment and habituation.

Abu Ali Ibn Sina emphasizes the formation of hard work in the spiritual and moral education of children in the family and at school, encourages parents to teach their children trades, glorifies work. It shows the negative impact of living a life without work on the child. In particular, Abu Ali Ibn Sina's thoughts about the unity of mental, moral, aesthetic and physical education and the ways of their implementation are still gaining social importance and meaning. deserves attention as a spiritual value.

According to Abu Ali Ibn Sina's teaching, moral development is a process unique to the human race, because it can not only determine the border between truth and falsehood, but also distinguish a friend from an enemy, relying on the great power of thinking. In their works, the scholars of our country emphasized that it is important for parents who hope for good manners of their child to regularly familiarize them with the following aspects of good manners, which are the basis of good behavior:

- pay attention to the fact that your child is sweet, gentle, modest and humble in dealing with people;
- sharing people's happiness, caring for their sorrows, not betraying their property, encouraging good and forbidding evil are the qualities characteristic of those with good character. Therefore, try to inculcate these qualities in your child from childhood;
- teach your child that gossiping, disrespecting others, treating others based on their reputation, wealth or position is also impolite when dealing with others;
- pay attention to inculcating in the children's hearts to listen to their words quietly, answer only their questions, and strictly follow their orders when dealing with older people and teachers.



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From time immemorial, our forefathers attached great importance to the good manners and manners of boys and girls. Therefore, in the religion of Islam, morality is included in the line of faith.

When raising a child, usually the father is more involved in the education of boys, and the mother is more involved in the education of girls. Of course, it is important to take into account the level of the child. You should not be in a hurry to see the result when the child achieves something. For example, until the age of two, they are brought up only with sweet words and caressing. Up to the age of five, a child explores the environment, acquires basic information at this age.
